

New Rider Course

What to expect?

When you take a New Rider Course at All American Harley-Davidson Riding Academy you will:

- Learn to ride on a genuine Harley-Davidson motorcycle.
- Get in-class and on-range instruction from Motorcycle Safety Foundation (*MSF*) and Harley-Davidson Certified Coaches.
- Learn to safely accelerate, shift, brake, and turn in limited spaces, along with maneuvers like controlling skids and mastering the swerves.
- Earn an MSF Basic RiderCourse Completion Card, which will exempt you from any further testing at MVA and score you a “M” endorsement and discount on motorcycle insurance in Maryland.

What will you need?

- You'll need a valid car driver's license and be able to ride a bicycle.
- The minimum age to take this class is 16 years and 6 months.

Course Cost: \$429 Includes:

- All classroom materials.
- Use of a Harley-Davidson® 500cc Street Motorcycle.

To Participate Students Must:

The following are State of Maryland requirements

- Students must be able to speak, read and understand the English language. Unfortunately, no interpreters are allowed. No other language material can be provided.
- Complete the online E-course prior to first class day.
- Motorcycle Safety Foundation E-course: after you have registered for the class you will receive an email with a link and information on how to obtain the E-course. This online course is no charge to you, with a link, if you pay for the online course, you WILL NOT be reimbursed.
- Failure to complete this online course prior to class will result in a dismissal from the class and a refund will not be given. The State of Maryland requires that you complete the E-course before class begins or we cannot allow you to proceed with the class
- Arrive 15 Minutes prior to the start of all class session. Tardiness may result in dismissal from course and forfeiture of class fee.
- Arrive completely prepared for class as described in email from program manager.

- Students who are under the age of 18 must report to the first day of class with their parent/guardian, who must sign the waivers in the presence of the class instructor.
- Provide your own PERSONAL SAFETY GEAR:
 - DOT compliant helmet - (*old helmets cannot be accepted. Must have new updated sticker in the back of the helmet: FMVSS 218 CERTIFIED*)
 - Eye protection (*helmet face shield or safety eyewear*)
 - Full fingered gloves
 - Jacket or long sleeve shirt
 - Full length jeans or riding pants without holes
 - Over-ankle riding boots.

Instructors will review your gear when you arrive. If you do not meet the requirements, you will not be allowed to participate in range exercises. Please allow us to assist you find excellent riding gear to help keep you protected and comfortable.

Out of State License Holders:

- You are responsible for understanding your home state rules and regulations concerning the Class license or M endorsement. As proof of successful completion, we will issue only a Maryland Motorcycle Safety Course Completion Certificate to all Out of State license holders, which may not meet the requirements in your home state.
- Please contact your home MVA to make sure your successful completion and the card we issue will be recognized for licensure in your State.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

Please read the following refund and cancellation policy carefully.

If your schedule changes and you must cancel or reschedule, you will receive a full refund for cancellations at least two weeks prior to the class start date. Unfortunately, if you cancel after the two-week deadline, we cannot offer a refund. The state of Maryland requires you to attend the entire class so if you do not show up or are late for any part of the class, you will be considered as having withdrawn from the course and the course fee cannot be refunded.

The State of Maryland requires that you complete the online training course (E-course), attend all classroom units and all range exercises to qualify for your "M endorsement".

If at any point your instructor believes you are endangering yourself or other students, you may be asked to withdraw from the class. You may also voluntarily withdraw from the course if you do not feel comfortable continuing. All American Harley-Davidson can offer to you one opportunity to enroll in a different class at no charge during the same calendar year. To graduate and get your "M" endorsement, you are required to start the new course from the beginning, and it is based on availability.
